The above is subject to fulfillment of the following conditions: -

- The approval is based upon the documents /data/information uploaded/submitted by the school online/offline. The school will be responsible for its genuineness. In case of any discrepancies, necessary action will be initiated against the school as per Affiliation Byelaws.
- The school will follow the RTE Act, 2009 and NCTE and the Rules made thereunder and the
 instructions issued thereon by the respective State /UT Govt. and the BSB from time to
 time. The school will also abide by the conditions prescribed, if any, by the State
 Government concerned.
- 3. The school should follow all the provisions contained in the Affiliation Bye Laws of Bhartiya Shiksha Board.
- 4. The school should go through the syllabus. The school is also advised to regularly visit BSB websites, i.e., www.bsb.org.in. Also, school should create its own school website for display of all the information required as per BSB norms.
- 5. The school must renew mandatory certificates from time to time.

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- 6. The school shall be solely responsible for any legal consequences arising out of the use of school name/logo/society/trust or any other identity /activity related to running of school affiliated to BSB. All legal expenses incurred by the Board, if any, arising out of these circumstances, shall be borne by the school.
- 7. The school shall possess valid fire safety certificate and Building safety certificate during functioning of the school which shall be renewed from time to time as per norms by the state and central government.
- 8. The school shall arrange to create separate email id for the Examinations in coordination with Controller of Examination.
- 9. Service conditions pay and allowance and other benefits to the employees of the school shall be in no way less than that of corresponding employees working in Government Schools of the State in which the school is located. An undertaking to this effect must be sent to B.S.B.
- 10. The school shall prescribe Bhartiya Shiksha Board Text Books in the classes and subjects in which these have been published by the Board if the board books are not published/available for the said purpose in that case the school shall prescribe NCERT books and also Teacher Training provided by the Board is mandatory. (as per BSB Affiliation Bye-laws chapter 2 clause 2.4.7)
- 11. The school and its records should be open for inspection by an officer/official of the Board or an authorized representative of the Board/State Educational Department at any time and the school shall furnish information as may be asked for by the Board/State Government from time to time.
- 12. The rate of tuition fee and other fees charged should be commensurate with the state norms.
- 13. The admission to the school should be open to all without any discrimination on the ground of religion, cast or race, place of birth or any of them.
- 14. No unrecognized classes shall run within the premises of the school or outside in the same name of school.
- 15. The school is henceforth authorized to issue Transfer Certificates (TC) ONLY to students who will be completing their 8th class examinations in the year, 2025. Issuance of TC to any other students is absolutely prohibited. Any breach of this condition will compel the Board to pursue legal action against the school authorities.
